



Stars are important in the story of Jesus. A star led the wise men to Jesus. Use the color code to color each star.









It's the first Sunday in the Christmas season.

On these 12 lines EITHER write 12 of your favorite things about Christmas OR list all the gifts in the song "The 12 Days of Christmas"—your choice!




Christmas lasts 12 days! Many hundreds of years ago, people celebrated from December 25 until January 5. That's where "The 12 Days of Christmas" song comes from!






But you might not want to ask how old they are!
