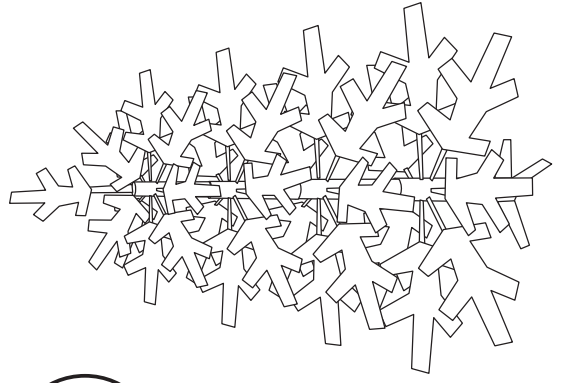
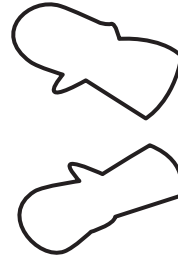
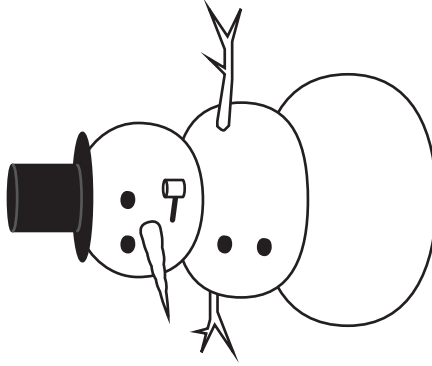


## Lent means SPRING!

Lent is a time that we prepare our hearts for Easter.




Lent means spring. Lent always starts right around the beginning of spring.


