


ORDINARY TIME

Ordinary kind of means normal.





Draw the welcoming church that goes with this front door. Color the front door Pentecost GREEN!


Sundays left in the Season after Pentecost



FUN WITH YOUR CHURCH BUILDING


Church buildings are all different, but most have these parts:
