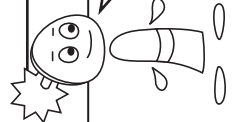
Some people carry burdens like injuries or illnesses.

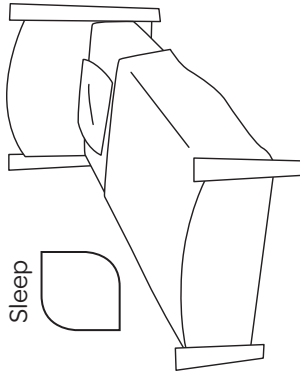

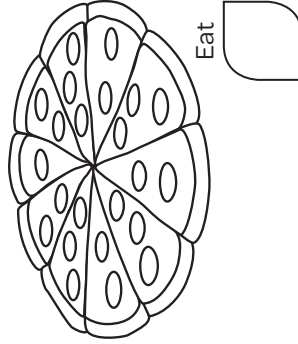


The season after Pentecost is sometimes called "Ordinary Time."

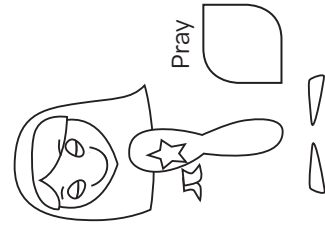
Ordinary doesn't mean boring. It just means that the numbered weeks follow an order. What things do you do in order? Number the pictures below to show what order you follow each night.



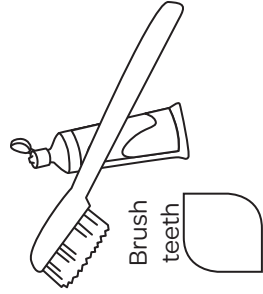

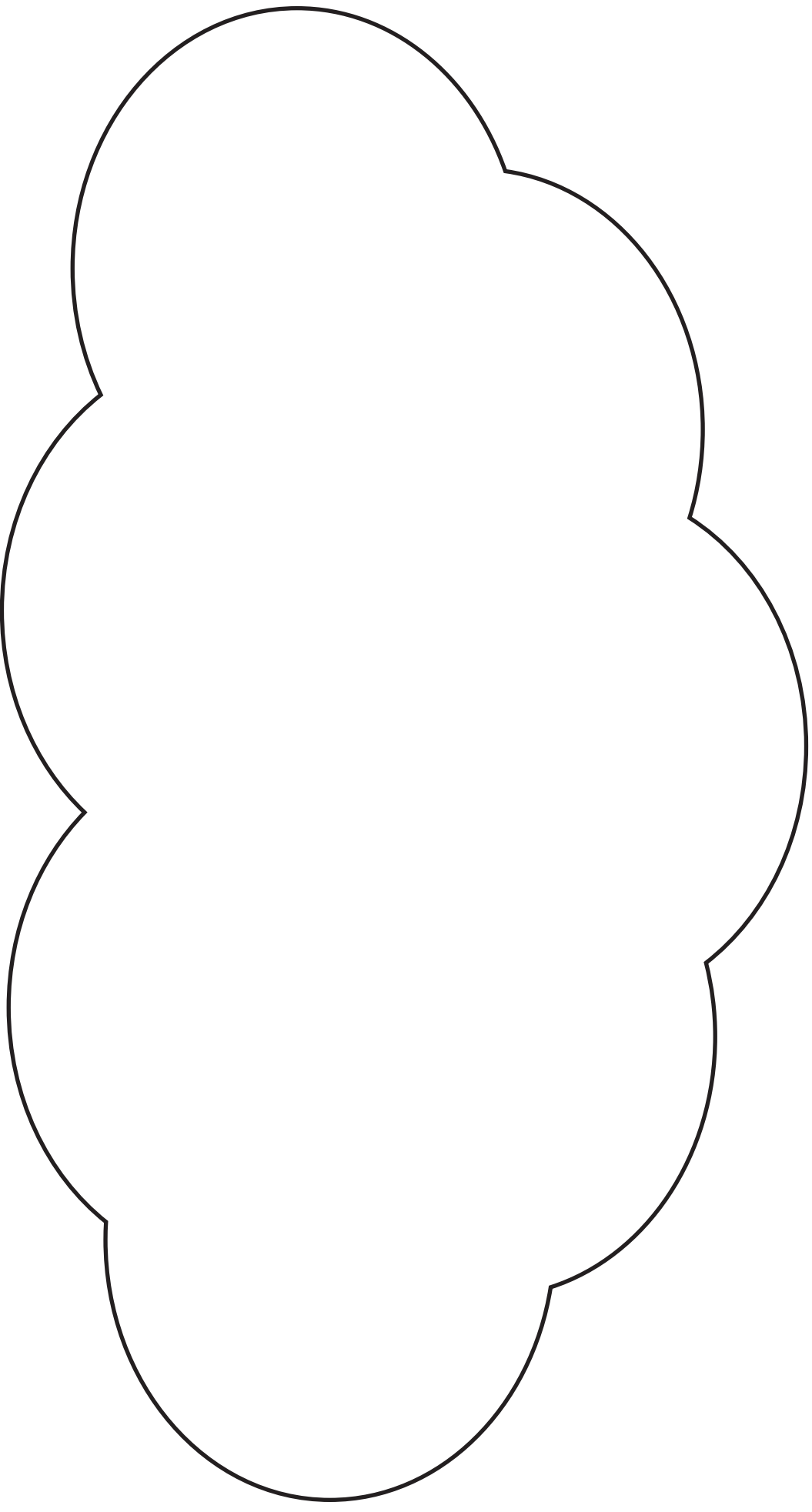
